The Kankakee Farmers Market is held on Saturdays from 8:00—12:00 pm from May 6 through October 28 (set up begins at 6:30 a.m.) Date requests will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis. Locations are not guaranteed and the location of booths may be relocated. Once scheduled, Kankakee Farmers Market staff will verify dates/locations for your non-profit organization.
